RON'S REPORT

Hello again boys and girls. Heading up the news is that another year is coming to an end. That means it's time to buy a 2015 membership card. If you come to the December 14 gun show, Dawn will be there to sign you up for 2015. If you can't make the show just fill out the membership application on the bottom of the third page of this newsletter. The dues are still the same price - that is \$40 for the year.

As I promised last month, here are the dates for the shows at the Evergreen Hall in Chilliwack. January 11, February 8, April 19, May 24, June 21, July 12, August 9, September 20, October 4, November 14-15 and December 8. The March 7-8 BIG SHOW will, of course, be held at Heritage Park in Chilliwack and it's not too soon to book tables either. But back to the Evergreen Hall, the new table price has to be \$20 per table as our costs have increased. However, we are going to take yearly table holders again this year. Your cost would be \$180 per table for the 10 one-day shows. At this time there will be a two table limit. Anyone who hasn't signed on yet can do so at the December 14 show.

I've included a small map showing the Evergreen Hall location. I think it will give you a better idea of how to find the complex. Chilliwack is a place where a map is a must because it seems none of the old part of the city was very well planned.

Now as you all know we always try to do something nice for members. With this thought in mind we will hold our first show in Chilliwack's Evergreen Hall on January 11 to help celebrate Vice President Art Hoivik's birthday on that day. So an early happy birthday, Art!

More news that is hard to listen to. The day before the November 15-16 show, I got a call from a work mate of Bruce Ledrew. Bruce had him call because he had just been taken to the Columbian Hospital for open heart surgery. So far I've got no more news. However, please join me in wishing Bruce a speedy recovery and looking after his tables again.

Now the show. Well, Saturday we had a big crowd as you would expect. Among the crowd was an old time life member, Ray Myarshol. He retired to Aldergrove some years ago. He told me how happy he is for the move to Evergreen as he is only 20 minutes away from there. Another member who dropped out in 1992 when his wife died came in Saturday. Mostly it was positive and lots of members looking forward to the new shows. Some people will drop out. Twenty years ago when we moved to the Engineers' Hall from 22nd and Renfrew there were people I never saw again! It's been a fact of life every time we've moved a show venue since we started in 1970. Anyhow, most regulars signed up and a few new ones also. As mentioned previously, we are going to have more room. We will start out with 80 tables, with room for at least 8 more and lots of aisle room. Our last show including the stage was 69 tables. So we will start taking table bookings at the December show. Something else I want you to remember is, there will be NO newsletter next month. We don't want to compete with Christmas mail. You'll just have to try and remember that our January 11 show will be at the Evergreen Hall in Chilliwack.

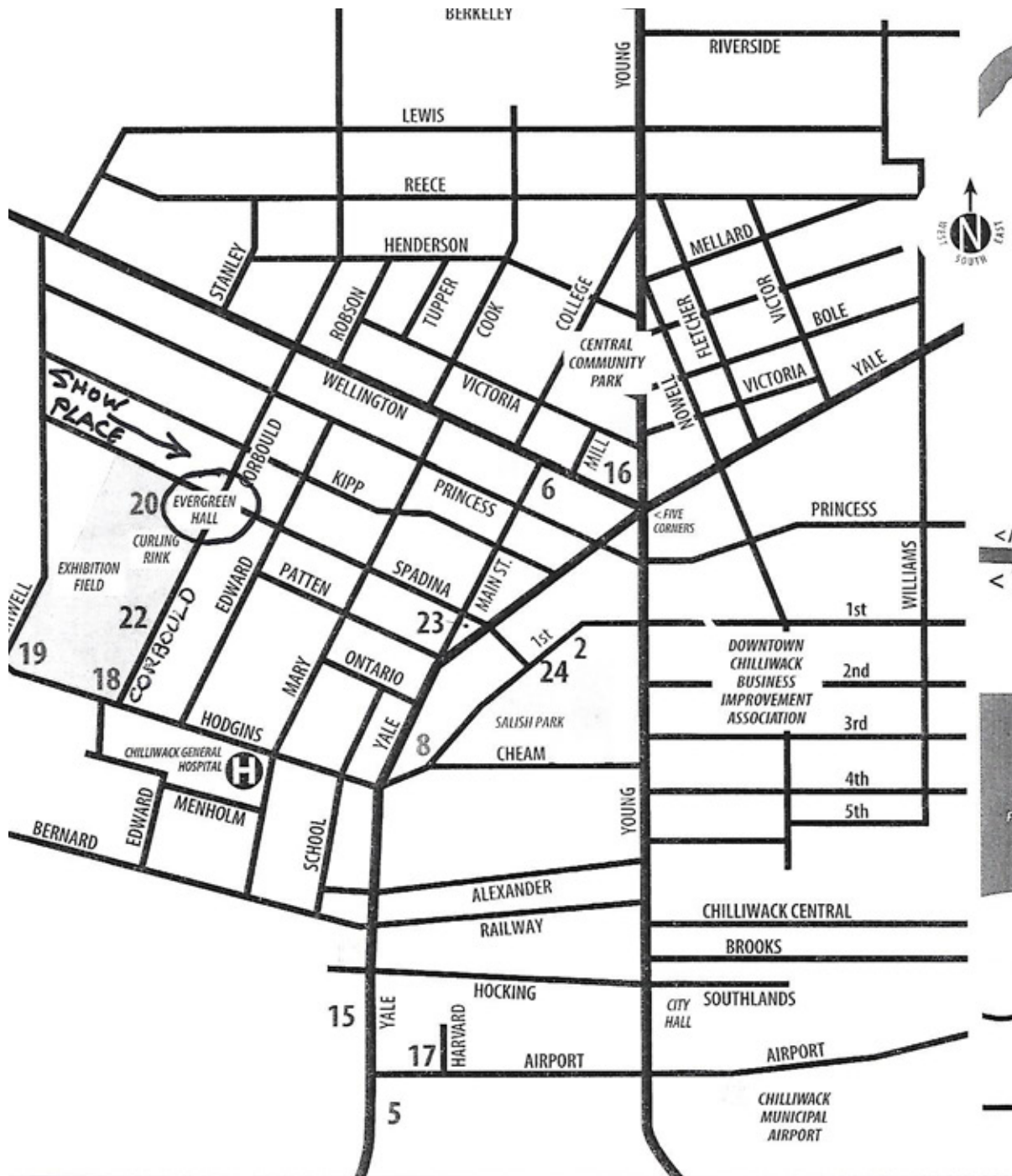
