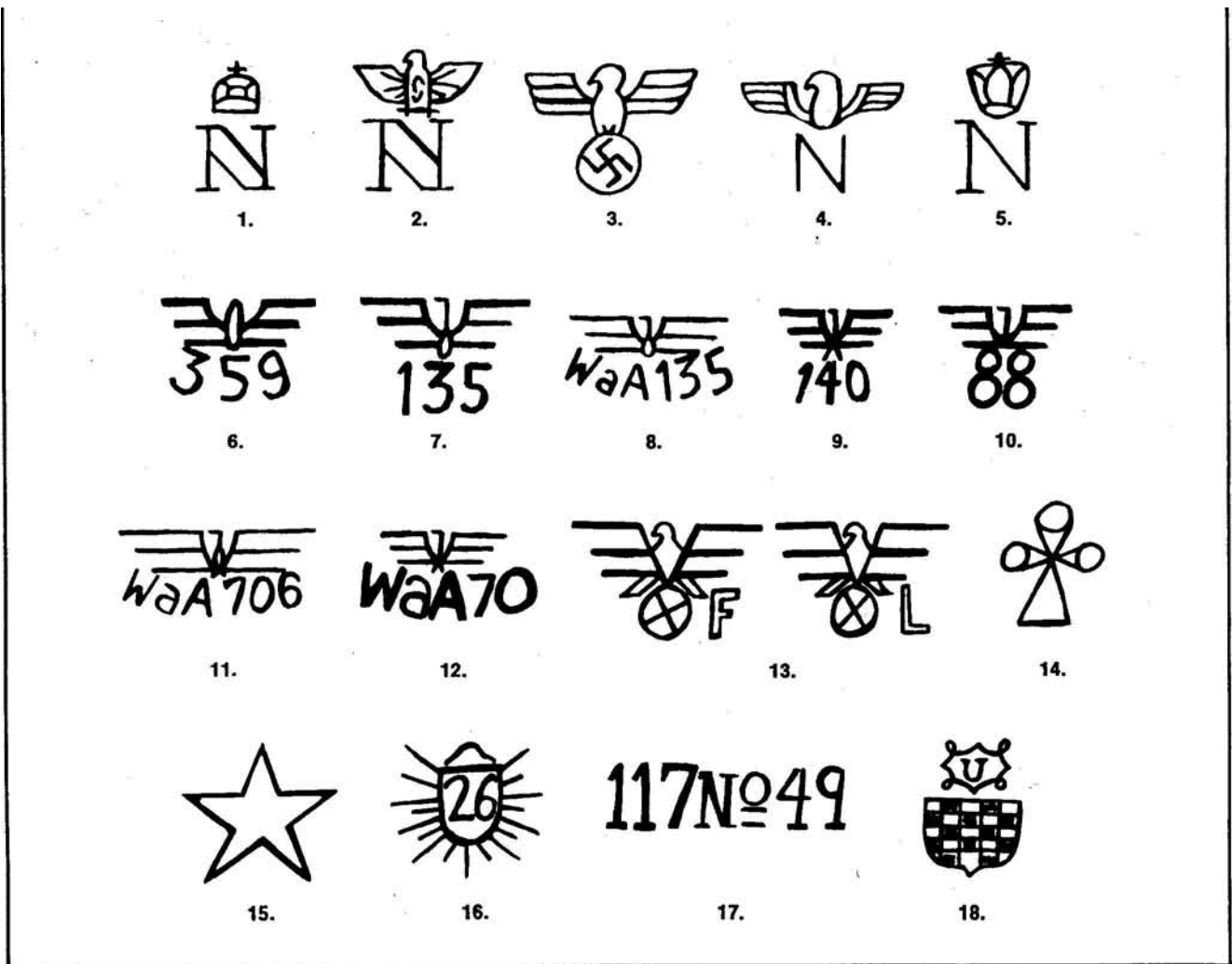

Explanation Of HP & P.38 Proof Markings

1. Found on HPs manufactured before April, 1940. Located on right side of frame in front of serial number, and on right side of barrel block and locking block.
2. Found on HPs manufactured after April, 1940, and on the Mod. P.38 in the positions mentioned for number 1.
3. Proof mark for all variations of the Military P.38 and the ac 45 zero-series. Located on the left side of the barrel block and locking block, and on the right side of the slide between the two Waffenamts stamps.
4. Police Commercial Proof, found on the Walther and Mauser Police models. Found on the left side of the slide by the serial number, and on the barrel and locking block.
5. Variation of the HP commercial proof. This proof used on all barrels manufactured by the East Germans after the war's end. Found on the underside of the barrel.
6. Waffenamts stamp used on all military P.38s manufactured by Walther. Located on the left side of the frame, twice on the right side of the slide, and on the barrel and locking block. On all small parts of P.38s before December, 1941.
7. Waffenamts stamp for Mauser P.38s of 1942 and 1943 manufacture. Located in all places mentioned in number 6.
8. Waffenamts stamp for Mauser P.38s of 1944 and 1945 manufacture. Located on positions mentioned in number 6.
9. Waffenamts stamp for Fabrique Nationale, Leige, Belgium. Located on the frames and slides shipped to Walther.
10. Waffenamts stamp for P.38s manufactured by Spreerwerke, Berlin, Germany. Located on left side of frame, right side of slide and on barrel and locking block.
11. Waffenamts stamp for Erste Nordboehmische Metallwarenfabrik, Niedereinsiedel, Czechoslovakia. Manufactured magazines for P.38s. Found on rear of magazines with code jvd.
12. Waffenamts stamp for Boehmische Waffenfabrik, Prague, Czechoslovakia. Found on the front left side of the barrel block on barrels shipped to Walther, used on P.38 reworks.
13. Stamps for the two different police acceptance offices. Found on Walther and Mauser police P.38s on the right side of the slide. Usually accompanied by single Waffenamts stamp.
14. Marking found on the frames of French produced P.38s, usually under the left grip panel.
15. Design of the French Nitro proof. Found on the right side of the slide, and on the barrel block and locking block of French produced P.38s.
16. Typical VOPO rework or acceptance mark. Generally found on the left side of frame, trigger guard, or slide.
17. Swedish military issue number located on either the left or right side of Swedish Contract HPs.
18. Design of Shield found on the right side of slides of the Croatian Contract HP.
