I quickly, too quickly, thought, "Now there's a chance for me to learn a lot about new products for this year." I didn't flip through the book, I just got out my money (\$10.95 + tax). That surprised me some as I haven't bought a gun magazine in years. At that time they ran around \$1.50 each. Anyhow, I got home and sat down prepared to learn about everything new this year. Lots of you already know how popular the so called "black guns" are. This darn book had page after page after page of nothing but "black guns". I realize they are the modern thing and to some eyes are things of beauty. I do not belong to that school of thought. Those pictures of them just reminded me of a pictured display of the old time bumper jacks! I was looking forward to looking at the real wood that was bolted to blued steel. In summation, I won't be buying anymore current gun books!

Now, here is some really nice news. If you will remember, I told you Mike Wallace told us that, since we moved out to Chilliwack, we have a larger surplus of money. Enough that we could increase our donations as well as our own term deposit. The donations were sent out after the last show. Well, the other day I got a phone call from the lady at CKNW Orphans' Fund. She thanked us profusely and told me how much they appreciate all the money that we have donated over the last few years since our slate took office. She is going to get in touch with me next month and give me copies of letters that will explain how appreciative some of the folks are of our help. I told her that gun guys and girls are always ready to help someone in need. I've been involved with gun people most of my life and have seen firsthand how quickly they are to offer help when it's needed. I'm very proud to be a member of such a wonderful fraternity. I'm certainly proud of all of our Club members! The following are a couple of samples of folks our Club are helping and I may get more as time goes by.

Emalin and Caitlin are 12 year old twins diagnosed with Rubinstein Taybi Syndrome and Autism. Their 8 year old sister, Madison, is diagnosed with Fetal Alcohol Syndrome, ADHD, DCD and a mild intellectual disability. Their mother left the family several years ago and, the girls along with another sibling live with their single father. All three girls have been assessed and referred to a behaviour consultant to implement ongoing therapy and support to encourage independence and effective communication.

Thank you for helping fund behaviour therapy for Emalin, Caitlin and Madison!

David is 4 years old and diagnosed with Cerebral Palsy right-sided hemiplegia. For the past two years, David has shown delays in gross motor, fine motor and speech development. David is able to walk independently, but has extremely poor balance due to the increased muscle tone in his right side. He also has a flat left foot and suffers from pain on both feet. David's physiotherapist recommended a right ankle-foot orthosis and left custom foot orthotic to help his gait and alignment. David is one of four children living with his single, low income mother.

Thank you for helping fund orthotics for David!

Now, as I've mentioned many times before, if you're going into a fight, line up as many folks as you can on your side. The above is one of the ways we can get a lot of extra support. This way they can see that we care about others in a serious way. With "son of daddy" now as prime minister we have to be prepared. It will make it more difficult for them to paint us up as "Bang Gunly" when the facts aren't there to point to. It's certainly a MUCH better way to use our surplus cash than put on gala directors' dinners or paying for signs that just say we don't want more gun control. So preaching to the choir accomplishes NOTHING. But pointing to the donations we've made to kids who need help over the years has lots of impact on thinking people. The "abject followers" of our society are never going to be swayed.

Well boys and girls, more bad news. At the last show 08/07, I was told that Dave Hardy of Salmon Arm had a heart attack. He was taken to the hospital and apparently repaired enough that he is now back home. Dave, we ALL wish you a speedy recovery. More now, I was talking to Al Olson of Lumby who told me his brother was found lying on the floor with a severe stroke. It's unknown for how long but he was taken to the hospital and a week later to a hospice. In less than a week he passed away. We ALL send our sympathy, Al. He also told me the table he had booked at the Vernon show had to be cancelled. He has no one who can help him with his wheelchair. I thought this would be the very best of therapy. However, he said his legs are still useless. So Al, keep pushing! Remember you're a sailor!

I talked to Jim Cox at the show who told me he had some kind of open heart surgery. He showed me his scars which made it look like he was put together with zippers. I am happy to report that everything went well and he looks GREAT! There always has to be some good news to help balance all the bad news.

Last month I explained the rules for getting a yearly table. Remember, pay for the year and get one month free. So, I took my own advice, I've paid for next year's tables and booked my tables for the November 12-13 two-day show. The tables will go fast so don't wait too long. Tables are \$45 each and that includes a free breakfast Sunday morning. The November show is NOT included in your yearly package. These have to be booked separately and cost \$45 per table. So, book with Art or Jennifer as soon as you can then you're assured of getting your regular tables.

I guess you all noticed Jennifer's wrist was bandaged at the last show. Apparently she broke her left wrist. She is left handed so she had to remove the wrapping any time she had to write something. So, heal fast, Jennifer, we need you. To the rest of you boys and girls, be kind to Jennifer until the bandage is off, at least.

Has anyone noticed how lucky we are to have a new member who picks up the extra newsletters from Jennifer and delivers them to the visitors? Thanks, Norman! We sure appreciate the effort.

Art just called regarding folks who are dealers in new merchandise wanting tables at shows we have in Evergreen Hall. Some of these people are discounting the stuff they sell. I've seen it in some other shows I've attended. It makes club shows less of a club show and more like a big box discount store. As I said, I've seen it and watched the real collectors, who usually come to socialize at shows, just slowly drift away. We discussed the issue between us and both think alike. We can let them rent tables at the March show where we have antiques as well as guns and militaria. However, the one-day shows are more a social event where we trade, buy, sell and visit amongst the rest of the members.

We are going to discuss this thoroughly at next month's directors' meeting. But for now, nothing will be changed. Anyhow, the September show is sold out and a waiting list.

The August shows, because of vacations, weather, etc. are always a little slower. The last show was no exception. However, everyone seemed happy. No one came to tell me they had a lousy show. I know you're all waiting for this: yes, I brought two nice guns and took the same nice guns home again. Are any of you very surprised? I did sell enough to make expenses and I certainly enjoyed all the visiting with everyone. I've said this so many times before, there is always someone who shows up that I haven't seen for ages. Also, I always meet some new and interesting people. So I always learn something new at every show.

I noticed a few of our regulars were absent but Art managed to get all the tables covered. It was over halfway through the show before it hit me some regulars were missing and different faces were at those tables. I meant to get the attendance number and forgot until I was on my way home. I also forgot to ask Tony how many guns he had checked out. I forgot that also.

If any of you boys or girls have any ideas that would make the shows or the Club better, don't keep the ideas to yourself. Tell Art or me and it will be brought up at a directors' meeting and discussed and maybe modified a little.

Well boys and girls, I don't think there is anything more to report. So until next time, be good to each other.
